

Town of Plympton-Wyoming - 2009 Budget Report

The Town of Plympton-Wyoming has finalized the 2009 Budget which includes a 5% tax rate increase in the municipal share of taxes.

2008 residential tax rate = 0.346529 for municipal portion only

2009 residential tax rate = 0.363854 for municipal portion only

On \$100,000 of assessment, the increase for the municipal portion only of 2009 taxes = \$17.32.

This budget includes many new capital projects. Some of these projects are:

Building addition on the Camlachie Firehall

Extra training for fire prevention for Fire Departments

Monument restoration work at various cemeteries

New playground equipment, new netting and an electrical upgrade at Canton Park

New flooring at Camlachie Community Center

Accessibility training and automatic power swing door for municipal office

Road reconstruction over the forcemain replacement on Queen Street with a paved shoulder for bicycle use

Finalization of Bridge Replacement on Uttoxeter Road

Shouldering, ditching and repairing on various roads

This budget also includes projects that we have applied to the Federal and Provincial Government's for infrastructure grants. The four applications are:

Michigan Line reconstruction and paving from Mandaumin Rd to Oil Heritage Rd

Bonnie Doone Bridge replacement as a walking trail

New salt dome at Reeces Corners Depot to meet regulations of salt storage

New parking lot at Camlachie Community Center

These projects will only be completed if grant monies are received.

The 2009 Budget includes an increase in water and sewer rates. In the Wyoming Area, there is an increase of 6% in water rates while the sewer rate will remain at 150% X water consumption. In the former Plympton Township Area, there is no increase in water rates with an increase of 3% in sewer rates.
